## PASTORAL - Beef Cattle Production

12 of our apprentices have completed their pre employment training towards their Certificate II in Beef Cattle Production. 9 have gone on to employment with Stations in the NT. GTNT expects to commence 30 over the next 36 months.

## ARTAP

Army Reserve Training Apprenticeship Program (ARTAP) is an Army Reserve initiative to recruit more reserves. Group Training (GTNT) is also the first point of contact in the recruitment of the ARTAP. As the Army is looking at increasing their reserve numbers they have developed an initiative where an apprentice can do their apprenticeship with the Defence Force and a Civilian host employer. Applicants must be at least 17 years of age to apply. The maximum days of work with the Army are 150 and ideally the other 150 days is with the civilian host employer. This is very flexible and is worked out at the beginning of each year to suit both parties. A table of weeks worked at each different host is then charted and is still slightly flexible throughout the year dependant on employer needs.
